Agenda

- 1. Call to order.
- 2. Treasurer's report: Finances are down due to subsidizing summer camp and Turkey Camp for the boys, plus a deficit in what the Troop collected from each boy for recharter (\$25) and what the Troop was eventually charged by the Council (\$60). Money from the upcoming pancake dinner will build the finances back up.
- 3. Recharter was discussed. The Troop only collected \$25 per Scout, but after fees were collected from families, the fee went up to \$33, the Council began requiring a \$15 insurance fee, and the Troop pays \$12 for *Boys Life*. That totals \$60 per boy, which is a shortfall of \$35 x 19 Scouts (\$665). This loss to the Troop will be communicated to the parents. We will discuss in the future how to raise yearly fees charged to parents and whether we need to break the payments up.
- 4. The January camp out will be held at Weches (Mission Tejas). Designated Scouts will be cooking three meals for rank advancement or Camping merit badge. They will also participate in a conservation project at the park.
- 5. The annual "Fat Tuesday" pancake dinner will be held February 13 and the leaders will meet on the 6^{th} to plan.
- 6. University of Scouting will be held in Palestine on January 27.
